2014 Baltimore Direct Services Grants Program

The Annie E. Casey Foundation creates a brighter future for the nation's children by developing solutions to strengthen families, build paths to economic opportunity and transform struggling communities into safer and healthier places to live, work and grow. Begun in 1995, the Casey Foundation's Baltimore Direct Services Grants (BDSG) program funds community-based or community-serving nonprofits that offer summer activities and programs for disadvantaged children and youth in Baltimore City.

The BDSG program awards up to \$20,000 to organizations to support such summer activities and programs. While all organizations with summer programs are encouraged to apply, the Foundation gives priority consideration to nonprofits aiming to serve the most vulnerable children, such as those who are homeless or academically at risk, with strategies to promote attendance and reading success. Programs may include, but are not limited to, ones that promote social development, academic advancement, cultural enrichment or recreational activities.

Program Guidelines

To apply, organizations must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be a nonprofit organization with 501(c)(3) status;
- Be an operating nonprofit for a minimum of three years;
- Maintain an organizational annual budget of no more than \$2 million;
- Provide services to Baltimore City youth;
- Be in good standing in the state of Maryland, as evidenced by a certificate of standing from the Department of Assessments and Taxation; and
- Not currently be a recipient of any other Casey Foundation grant awards.

How to Apply

Organizations must submit a cover letter, together with a completed application in the form described below, a budget and supporting attachments. The application and instructions are available online.
